Our last newsletter was in January, so it is definitely time to share a few updates with you all.

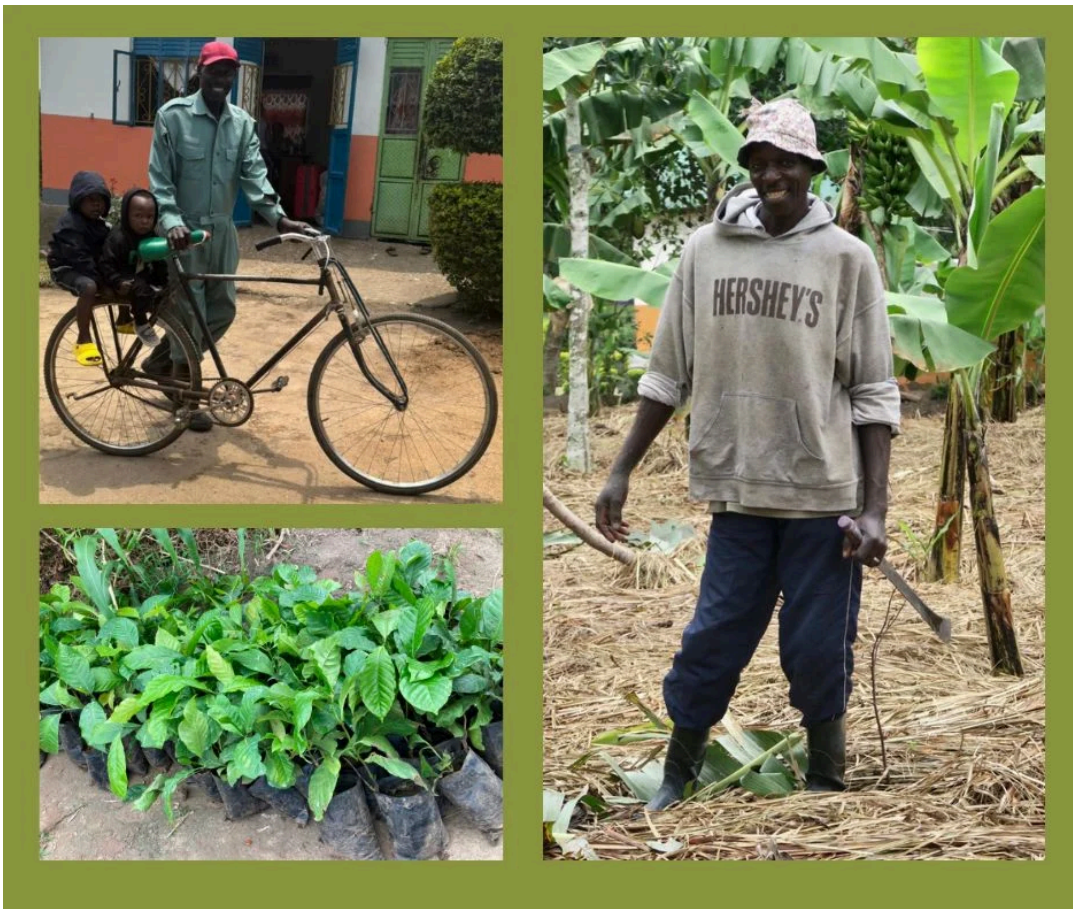
What has been happening at the Rainbow Hope Centre?

Three of our young people have received the results from their final National exams and graduated from Senior Six. Dickson, Joshua, and Dorcas have now all moved into employment. Dickson is teaching in a Primary school in Kampala; Joshua has also moved out of the centre but lives locally, working for a company that produces bottled drinking water. Dorcus is teaching at a Primary school in Lukaya. She is living with Dorah and Shakira in the halfway house at RHC. Dorah has begun a hairdressing apprenticeship, while Shakirah is currently still looking for an opportunity in hairdressing or beauty.

The remaining children restarted school in January, completed their first term, enjoyed the Easter break, and are now progressing through the second term of the school year. How quickly the time goes!

What else has been happening at RHC?

We are continually looking for ways to help the centre become more self-sustaining and have increased the amount of land used to grow vegetables, mainly for their own consumption. For those who are unaware, we do employ a full-time gardener. We would like to introduce Augustine, the RHC gardener, alongside some new coffee plants:



Yes, coffee plants! This spring, for the first time, the centre has planted a trial patch of coffee plants (105 seedlings). Coffee is Uganda's biggest export and a possible cash crop even when grown on a small scale. There is a cooperative of small coffee growers in Masaka that can advise, and assist with processing, though it will be three years before there is a harvest.

During the Easter break, the children were able to get involved and help with the digging and planting.



Fundraising:
