The building work was completed while we were there and the next stage is the installation of a new cooker by a professional, with some ventilation. A big thank you to everyone who donates and has enabled this essential work to be done!


The children are all growing up fast and in 2026 we will have some big changes. There will only be three of the children still in Primary school, adults now who are looking at opportunities for further education in and eight children in Senior school. The remaining four are all young adults now who are looking at opportunities for further education in Kampala, or moving into work, which creates some new challenges to consider
